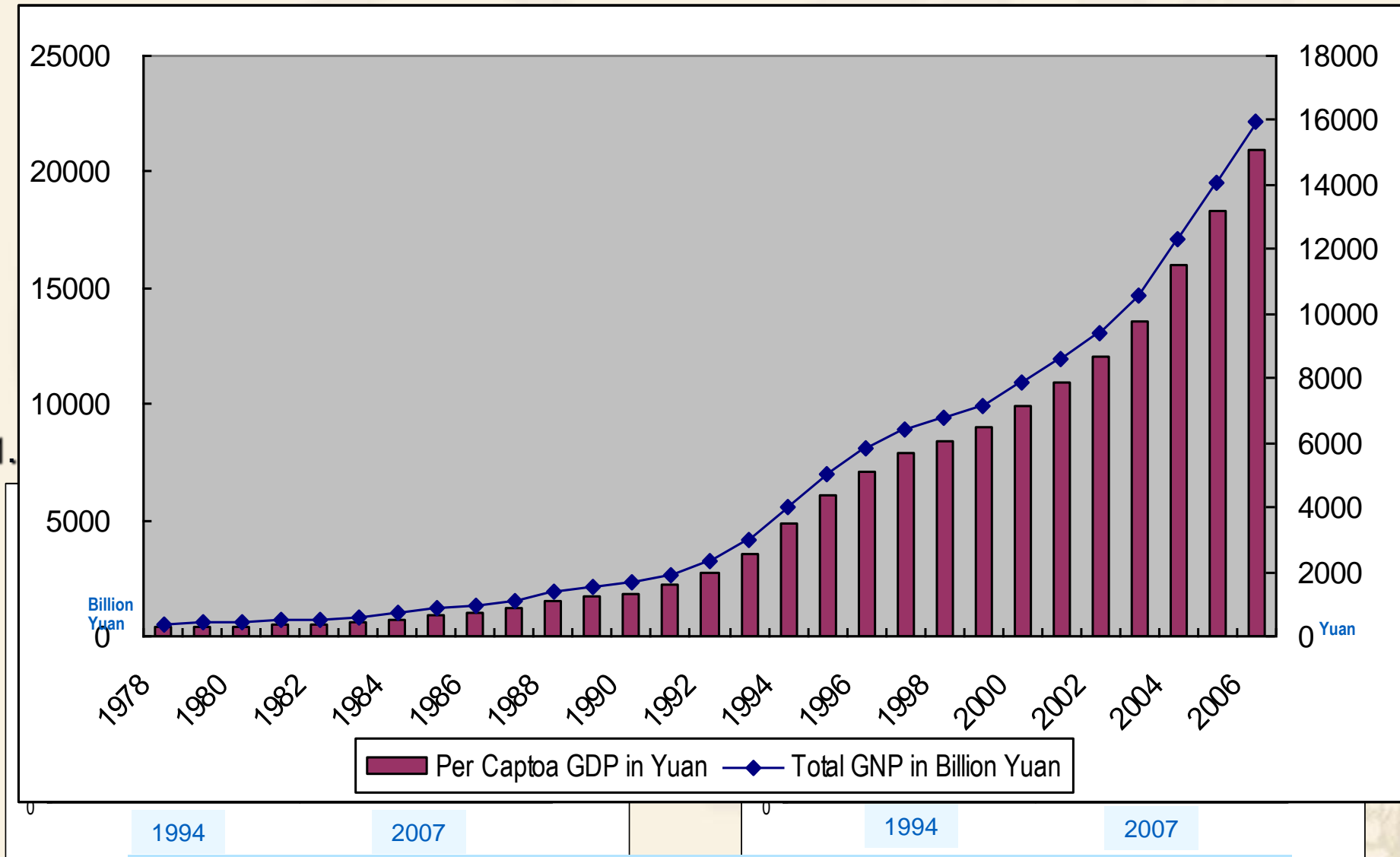

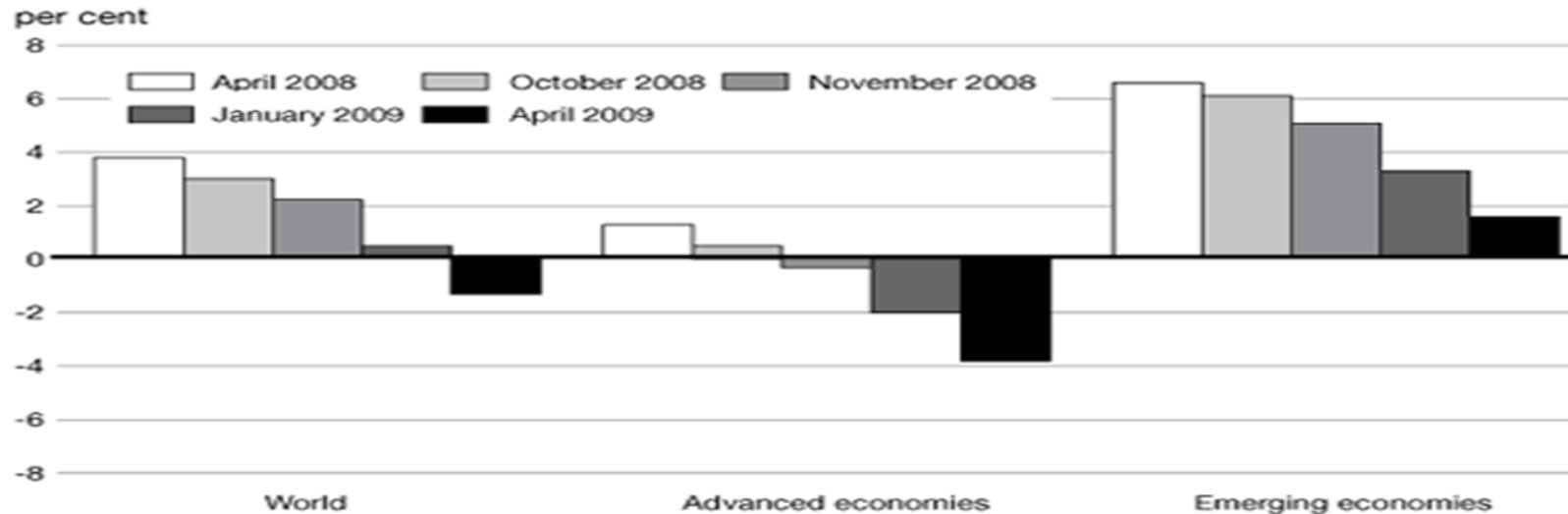
## Main Challenges:

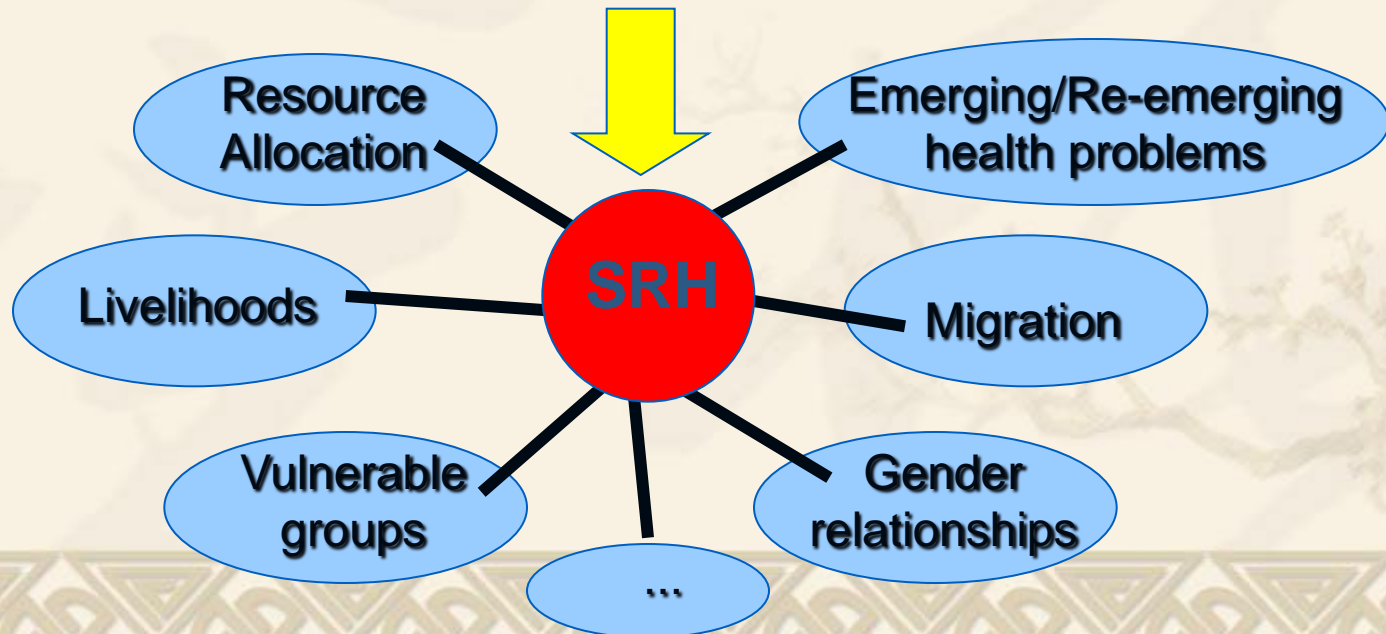

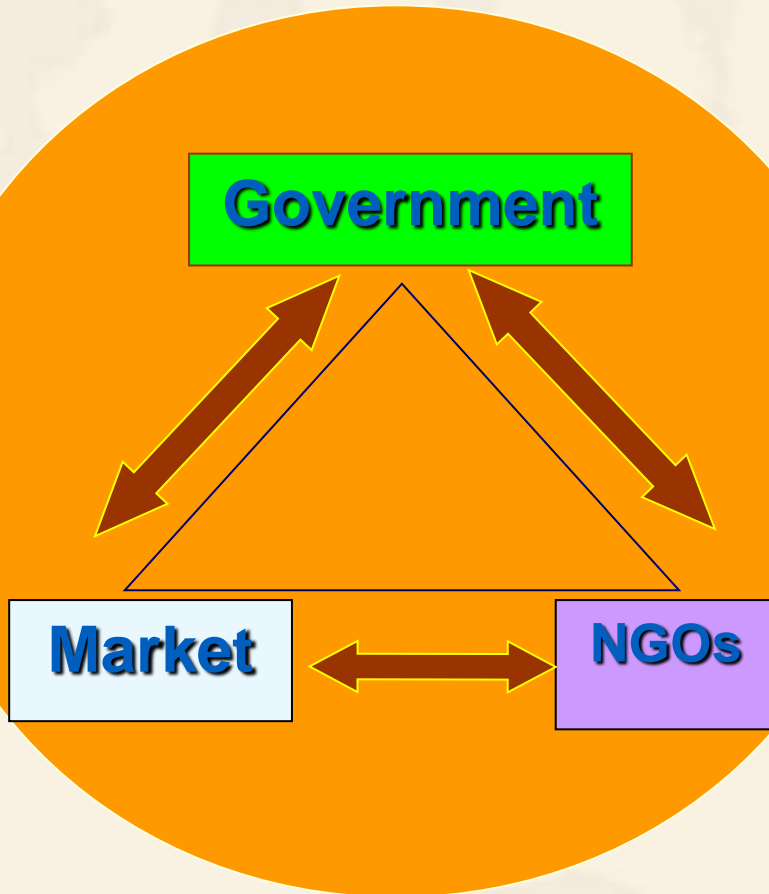
